OVERSEAS STUDENTS TUITION and NON-TUITION FEES 2018

Fees are subject to yearly increase

The College is registered to take Overseas Students from Preparatory to Year 12.

- An Application Fee of AU\$250.00 applies for all mainstream College applications.
- A student in Brisbane will be tested and interviewed at the College, subject to academic reports indicating above average ability. A supervised test may be organised by the College for a student who is overseas at an additional cost of approximately AU\$500. A personal interview may be required.
- Alternative entry for students 12 years or older, where English is a Second Language, is by application to the Secondary School Preparation Program through the International College where applicable. (Please note that the Primary School Preparation Program is not currently offered).

•	Accommodation Approval Fee Living costs in Australia: the average international student in Australia spends about AU\$360 per week on accommodation, food, clothing, entertainment, transport, international and domestic travel, telephone and incidental costs.	AU\$300
