Frequently Asked Questions about Accelerated Reader

What do I need to do, as a parent, for the Accelerated Reader program?

- 📖 Encourage your child to read for a minimum of 10 mins a day, at home

What book should they be reading?

- 📖 After completing the STAR reading test at school, your child will be advised of what their reading level range is (ZPD level). This will be a range of levels that your child can read between.

How do I know what level each book is?

- 📖 All books within the school library are labelled to identify the Accelerated Reader level that the book is set at.
- 📖 If your child would like to read a book from home, or the local library, visit www.arbookfind.com.au to check the level of the book to ensure your child is reading within their allocated reading level (ZPD level). Using the Advanced Search option, you can search by author, reading level/range or title. Do I need to record each book that my child reads?

- 📖 This will be automatically recorded in their account each time that they complete a quiz.

When will my child complete the quiz at the end of each book?

- 📖 The book quizzes can only be done during school time. There will be an opportunity for this to occur each time they complete a book. Once they have completed this short quiz, they will select a new book and continue reading.
