# International College

At Citipointe, international students can develop their English language skills right here on campus before entering their mainstream program. This means that they can make friends with local students and become familiar with the routines of a large Australian school while studying English. The International College offers intensive English language courses for students from a variety of countries including Japan, Korea, China, Hong Kong, Taiwan, Sri Lanka and Malaysia.

English preparation classes are conducted using the latest interactive technology. Students play sport and enjoy recess and lunch breaks with local students, and all their free time is spent on the mainstream campus with the Australian students.

Small class size means each student has individual attention from their teacher. English tests are conducted every ten weeks until the student reaches the level needed for entry to the mainstream.

For entry to Years 7-9, students need to demonstrate Level 5+.

For entry to Years 10-11, students need to demonstrate Level 6.

Our research interests include using music in the classroom to accelerate English development. Our aim is to help our students achieve a high level of English proficiency in as short a time as possible.



# Secondary School



The Secondary School includes Years 7 to 12. Students are encouraged to set high goals and work hard to achieve them. Our intent is to see our students achieve their personal best in their academic studies. A wide range of subjects is available for students to choose from. Our strong arts and sporting programs, and our attention to the teaching of Christian values, help to develop the whole person, body, mind and spirit.

University entrance is the goal of most of our students at Citipointe. The Australian Tertiary Admissions Rank (ATAR) ranks students for university entrance. An ATAR of 60 means you performed better than 60% of the students that year. The highest rank is 99.95, the next 99.90 and so on. In 2021:

23.5% of Citipointe students received an ATAR of 95.00 or above.  
41.6% of Citipointe students received an ATAR of 90.00 or above.
