

Fees, scholarships and bursaries



Citipointe's Schedule of Fees for 2024 is designed to be an all-inclusive tuition fee and will cover all curriculum-related activities. The tuition fees quoted can be paid annually, by term or by smaller, more frequent payment via Edstart. edstart.com.au/citipointe

The tuition fee will be inclusive of:

- day excursions
- weekly sport
- year level camps (with the exception of tourist or elective activities)
- secondary curriculum camps
- government examination fees
- academic competition fees

Items that are outside the all-inclusive fee and attract an additional fee are:

- certain co-curricular and extra-curricular sports and activities
- tutoring through Citipointe Christian College Academy and with the College's Academy of the Arts
- international travel under the International Student Outreach Program
- musical instrument hire
- sessions with the Independent Study Centre

No refunds can be made for events not attended

The College operates its own bus service and the fee is for a place on the bus. If one-way transport is required, the cost will be 50 percent of the above fee, subject to availability.

TEXTBOOKS AND STATIONERY

Stationery items and Primary textbooks are not included in the tuition fees. Secondary textbooks do not need to be purchased because of the College's textbook hire scheme (including electronic textbooks).

SCHOLARSHIPS—ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

Following the interview process, offers will be made in writing by the Principal. All applicants—both successful and unsuccessful—will be notified.

The College will offer a number of academic scholarships to students (excluding full fee-paying overseas students) seeking entry into Year 7 at the College, based on available funding. The value of each scholarship will be up to a 50 percent discount on tuition fees for Years 7 to 12.

Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of the results of the Edutest Scholarship examination, previous school reports and an interview with the Principal.

An invitation to attend an interview does not necessarily mean a scholarship will be offered. All College standards for enrolment must be met.

Actual results of scholarship examinations are confidential and not released by the College other than to the parents of participating students and relevant staff.

The College will not enter into a dispute regarding the awarding of the scholarships. Online registration and payment of fees is required to participate in the scholarship testing.

SCHOLARSHIP—EQUITY

Equity scholarships will be awarded for Years 7 to 12, normally commencing at Year 7. However, students may apply for a scholarship for any year level from Year 7 up to and including Year 10, dependent on vacancies in those year levels.

The College's normal enrolment application form, with a completed Equity Scholarship application form, must be completed and submitted during the application period in the year prior to entry. Terms and conditions apply to the Equity Scholarship and will be supplied with the acceptance form.

The College will normally offer one Equity Scholarship through the Cardo Foundation Scholarship Fund each year to cover tuition and other agreed expenses, funding permitted.

Selection is based on a combination of financial need and the student's ability to meet the criteria for general entry to the College based on its published considerations for enrolment.

BURSARY—HARDSHIP (ON APPLICATION ONLY)

Concessional hardship bursaries, on application only, for parents experiencing genuine hardship. Applications are only considered for short term temporary situations based on financial need. For further information contact the Business Office.

ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS AND BURSARIES

Citipointe awards scholarships with the expectation that scholarship holders will continue to maintain high standards of academic achievement, participate to the very best of their ability in campus and College life, and adhere to College policy.

Academic scholarships and bursaries are provided towards the all-inclusive tuition fees only. They do not cover other costs such as bus travel, excursions, uniform, books, sessions at the Independant Study Centre or additional tuition in Citipointe's Academy of Arts or Tutoring Academy, unless otherwise discussed and agreed to at the time of awarding the scholarship.

BILLING POLICY

The College will issue a notification of annual fees in January that will reflect the tuition and bus fees for the year (or within 14 days if a student commences during the year).

Statements of fees charged and owing will be issued according to the payment option selected. This will assist families in tracking their payments against the fees owing throughout the year.

The statement of account will be sent each month to show balances outstanding (if any), including any new charges for Academy and Music tutoring, etc, that may be added throughout the month, less any payments that have been received.

Payment of fees will be based on preferred arrangements as selected. Regardless of the frequency selected for tuition fee payments, please note the following due dates: -

- Academy tutoring charges are due and payable in the month they are billed.
- Independant Study Centre and Music tutoring charges are due and payable in the term they are billed.

DISCOUNTS

Discounts for lump sum payments in advance, paid by the due dates, apply as follows.

There is a 5 percent discount on the full year's tuition and bus fees only, if paid in advance by Friday 9 February 2024.

If you are paying direct to the College, a \$25 discount per term per full fee-paying student on the full term's tuition and bus fees only applies if paid in advance by the following dates.
